



Funding Application Information Sheet

The New Zealand Radiology Education Trust

The New Zealand Radiology Education Trust (NZRET) is responsible for utilising the income and capital of a trust fund. The purpose of the NZRET is to:

- promote or encourage research into the study or practice of clinical radiology and radiation oncology
- promote teaching and education in clinical radiology and radiation oncology
- undertake any other activities, and do any other things, which the Trustees consider will or may be of benefit of clinical radiology and radiation oncology, its facilities, or any of the services which it provides.

Annual Funding

NZRET has undertaken to award a minimum of NZ\$20,000 annually. The Trustees however, reserve the right to exercise their discretion with respect to that amount and consider NZ\$20,000 to be a minimum which may be exceeded depending on quantity and quality of applications for funding.

Funding Rounds

There will be two rounds of funding per annum.

The funding rounds will be advertised on the College website, through DoT networks and at the RANZCR New Zealand Annual Scientific Meeting.

Each funding round will have NZ\$10,000 available and each application is eligible for a maximum grant of NZ\$5,000.

Applications for funding

Those seeking funding from the Trust are required to complete the Funding Application Form and submit to trust@ranzcr.org.nz by the advertised dates.

If the application for funding is approved, the successful applicant will need to submit relevant receipts and/or invoices to the Trust and the amount will be reimbursed.
