

Radiology Training in Queensland

Registrar Recruitment

- The Queensland Radiology Training Network (QRTN) is responsible for Radiology specialist training in Queensland.
- Queensland Radiology training positions are advertised **twice a year**.
- The advertisements usually go out in **January and July**.
- Interviews are held approximately March for August commencement and August/September for February commencement. The positions are advertised on the Queensland Government website:

- The recruitment process covers vacant positions at **the five training hubs** – Princess Alexandra Hospital, Royal Brisbane & Women's Hospital, Gold Coast University Hospital, Sunshine Coast University Hospital and Townsville University Hospital
- The five independent training hubs **work together** with the registrar recruitment and the SEQ hubs take turns at coordinating the recruitment.
- Your email address will be added to the RBWH notification list. The coordinator will send you an email to advise you of advertisement dates, when they become available.
- It is also advisable that you check the above website for the advertisements as the time frames can vary from year to year.

Qld Health RMO Campaign

- The above process is completely separate from the **Queensland RMO campaign**. Registrars who are currently on the Queensland Radiology training program are required to re-apply for their positions each year through the RMO Campaign.

Director of Training Meetings

- The DoTs at RBWH are available for meetings on **Tuesday afternoons**.
- Due to the large number of requests for Director of Training meetings, there is a limit of

one meeting only per person with one of the DoTs.

- Therefore, additional meetings cannot be arranged for candidate's who re-apply for Radiology training through future recruitment processes.
- The DoTs are unable to meet with candidates after the closing date for applications until after the recruitment process has been finalised.
- It may be beneficial if you try to meet with the Directors of Training at the other four hubs, where possible, prior to the positions being advertised.
- If you do wish to meet with the DoT, please send your current CV to the Coordinator and an appointment for a DoT meeting can then be organised.
- DoT meetings for **interstate applicants** are only granted at the discretion of the Director of Training at the individual site.
